We arrange transport to and from the airport for boarders who arrive by air.

Boarders may arrive back at Boarding on the day before school officially starts, but not earlier than this as HAMPSTEAD HOUSE are closed during the holidays.

- Torch essential for power outages.
- A padlock with more than one key.
- Weekend bag.
- Coat hangers.
- · Stationery.
- Snacks optional (in a sealable plastic container to avoid attracting ants).
- We must have a COPY of a Medical Aid card or Medical Insurance.
- Some boarders bring computers, cell phones and other expensive equipment at their own risk. Large sums of money should be handed to the Registrar for safekeeping.
