Our History

In 2012, The British Academy opened its original campus in Centurion, initially focusing on part-time Cambridge courses and extra lessons. However, by January 2013, the demand for full-time tuition had grown significantly, leading to the incorporation of full-time courses into the standard curriculum. Within a year, TBA had produced at least five national first-place awards and numerous A* results, underscoring the strength of its academic programme.

In October 2013, TBA acquired its flagship Brooklyn Campus in Pretoria, moving to its current location early in 2014. This move was driven by the growing demand for a highly focused yet enjoyable academic environment. The expansion included a larger, better-equipped campus and an extension of the courses offered to include Foundation Level (Grade 8) and IGCSE-1 (Grade 9), ensuring the full high school curriculum is covered.



Since then, we have further expanded our Brooklyn campus to offer Pre-Foundation level (Grade 7). This addition allows us to provide a seamless and comprehensive educational journey from the early stages of secondary education through to the completion of A-levels, solidifying our commitment to academic excellence and holistic student development.

THE CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENTS

Cambridge Pre-Foundation and Foundation Level (Grade 7 to 9)

Cambridge Checkpoint tests are designed to assess learning at the end of Cambridge Secondary 1. These tests are available in English, mathematics, and science, and provide valuable feedback on learners' strengths and weaknesses before they progress to the next stage of their education. The tests are marked in Cambridge, providing schools with an external international benchmark for learner performance. Each learner receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report, giving schools detailed information and parents extra trust in the feedback they receive.

Cambridge IGCSE Level

The Cambridge IGCSE curriculum offers a variety of pathways for learners with diverse abilities, including those whose first language is not English. We support schools in constructing a curriculum that meets their unique needs. Starting with core subjects as a foundation, schools can easily add breadth and cross-curricular perspectives. Our approach encourages learners to engage with a wide range of subjects and make connections between them, fostering a holistic educational experience.

For schools, Cambridge IGCSE provides a flexible and stimulating curriculum supported by excellent resources and training. For learners, it enhances performance by developing skills in creative thinking, enquiry, and problem-solving. It serves as an ideal springboard to advanced study. Examinations are marked in Cambridge, providing schools with an external international benchmark for learner performance.

Cambridge AS and A Level

Cambridge International AS and A Levels develop learners' knowledge, understanding, and skills in several key areas:

- In-depth subject content,
 Independent thinking
- Applying knowledge and understanding to new and familiar situations
- Handling and evaluating different types of information sources
- Thinking logically and presenting ordered and coherent arguments

- Making judgements, recommendations, and decisions
- Presenting reasoned explanations, understanding implications, and communicating them logically and clearly
- Working and communicating effectively in English

We offer a choice of a range of subjects, and schools can offer them in almost any combination, allowing for an individualised curriculum. Learners can choose to specialise in a particular subject area or study a range of subjects. Cambridge International A Level is typically a two-year course, while Cambridge International AS Level is typically one year. Some subjects can be started at the AS Level and extended to the A Level, providing additional flexibility for students and schools.
